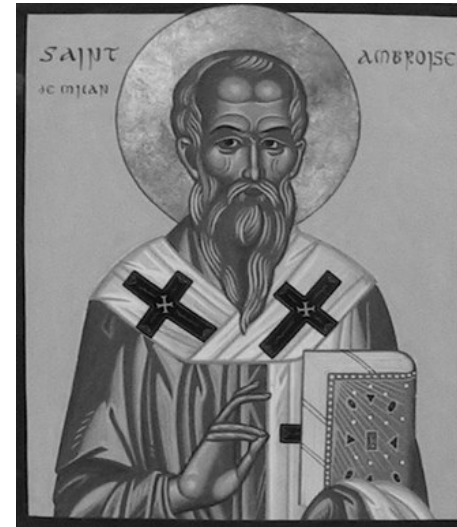

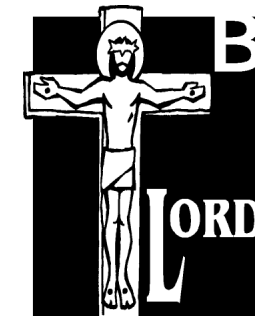

The proclamation of the Passion is central to the liturgy on this final Sunday of Lent. Because this is a B year in the three-year cycle of Sunday readings, the Passion accord-

ing to Mark is read. Lent ends on the afternoon of Holy Thursday. The season known as Triduum begins with the Mass of the Lord's Supper on that evening. **Triduum is celebrated as a unit** which is why the Mass of the Lord's Supper and the liturgy for Good Friday have no concluding rites. The final blessing does not occur until the end of Mass at the Easter Vigil.
