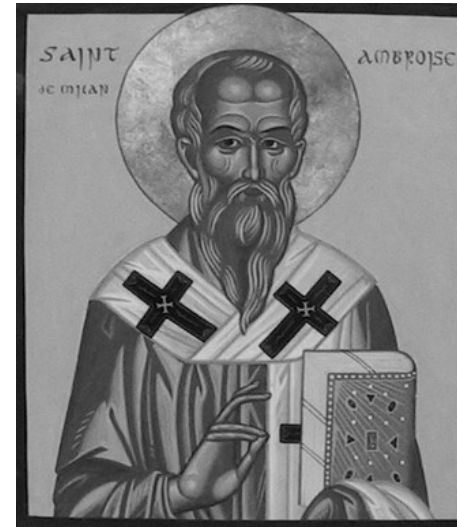
We haven't forgotten the people who volunteered to learn how to run the new sound and video system. We are still waiting for the last few pieces of equipment to be installed.

5. Of the remaining 33%, 32% of all deaths occur in hospitals, so you don't want to be there either.

But only .001% of all deaths occur during a worship service in church and even those are usually related to a previous physical disorder. Therefore, logically the safest place for you to be at any given time is in church!

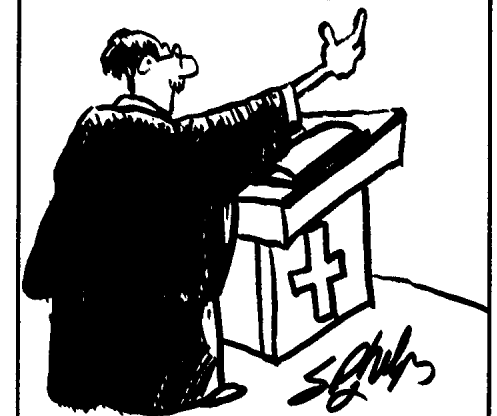
