Thanks to all the folk who helped with the Funnel Cake Booth at the Barlow Fair and special thanks to Jason Hall for organizing this fundraising project.

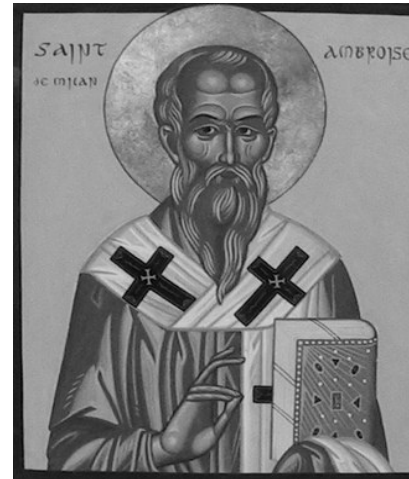

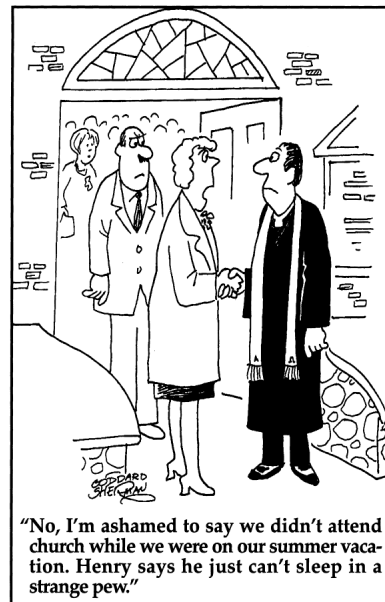
