Being serious about Lent...

Lent should make a difference in our lives; it started out as a retreat to prepare for Easter and baptism. Maybe you are the only one who notices the difference; that's ok, but something should be different than the rest of the year. Are you planning on "giving something up"? That is an honored traditional practice - it reminds us of our need to grow spiritually and the time or money we save can be used in the service of others. Are you "adding something new?" Attend a weekday mass; say a rosary, read the scriptures; support a project—all of those make a difference. *Attending Lenten devotion on Fridays and sharing a simple meal* with your parish family are powerful ways to turn to the lord. Knowing how unique our lives are the Church lets us choose what will be most beneficial for us but as a Catholic **the one thing we can not choose is to ignore lent and do nothing.** Our faith requires this of us.

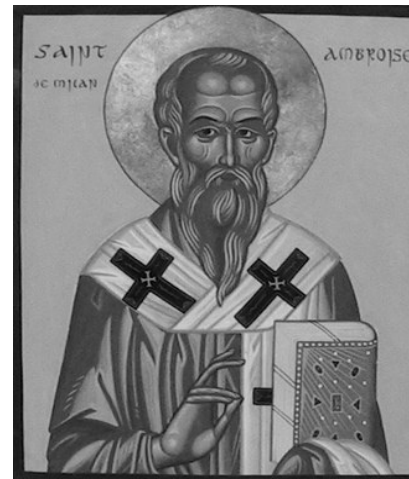
