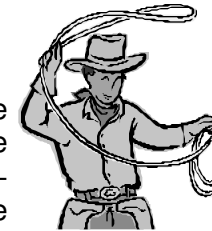

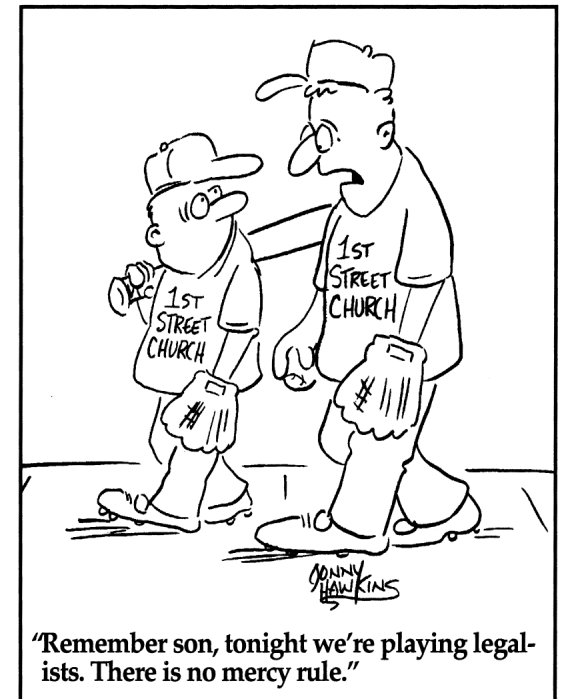

Last Call for Adult Altar Servers

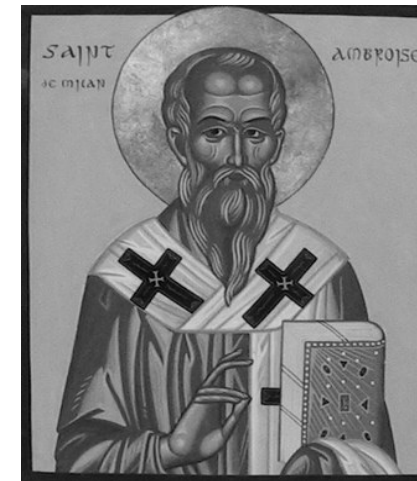
We have had several adults express an interest in being altar servers; this is common in some other parishes. Let Fr Bob know if you would be interested in some training in the near future.

The Deacon's Corner

What to wear to mass?

While the average Catholic may have to make a few decisions about what clothes they should wear to Mass on Sunday, the priest has it pretty easy. His wardrobe has been established by the Church over hundreds of years. The vestments a priest wears at Mass were actually the everyday "street clothes" that people wore in the time of Jesus and more than a thousand years after. These clothes were adopted by the Church for use in the liturgy and have stayed mostly the same since then. Some of the details and styles have changed through the course of history, but, in general, the priest's vestments are the same as they were almost two thousand years ago.

The first vestment that a priest puts on is the alb, a white robe. The name "alb" comes from the Latin word meaning "white" and it symbolizes purity. Altar servers also wear albs.

The cincture is a robe or belt that goes around the alb. It has traditionally been associated with chastity.

Over the alb goes the priest's stole. It is a long, narrow band of cloth that goes over the priest's shoulders and will match the color of his other vestments. The deacon also wears a stole, but his goes over the left shoulder and hangs at the right side. The stole symbolizes the cross of Christ.

Finally, the priest puts on a chasuble. This article of clothing comes from the cloak that everyone wore in the times of ancient Rome. The deacon's top layer is the dalmatic. It is similar to the chasuble, but is cut differently and has sleeves.

The vestments a priest wears at Mass were once normal clothes that everyone would wear. Now they stand out – and help us to remember the sacredness of the Mass. The priest and other ministers wear special garments, set aside for such an important event.
