Each week we need to feed about 70 hungry teenagers. You could prepare the meal at home and bring it in or you could bring the ingredients and cook it here. It would be a good idea to partner with someone to help distribute the cost and the work. The food needs to be at the church on Sunday evenings by about 6:15. You can just drop it off even better is you can stay and help serve. We will supply the drinks. Once we get people lined up we will set up a schedule so you know in advance when your turn will be. Parents, this is an excellent way to be involved with your teenagers and the lifeteen program. **We hope that each parent with kids in Life teen or Edge will volunteer so you can get a better feel for what the program is about.**

Here are some suggestions that we have done in the past but you are very welcome to come up with your own ideas too: *Sloppy Joes; Hot dogs; Cold cut sandwiches; Soup and bread; Any kind of pasta/sauce; Pizza; Tacos; Veggie trays and fruit are always a welcome side dish since some kids don't eat meat.* And, of course, cookies or some kind of dessert are great as well.

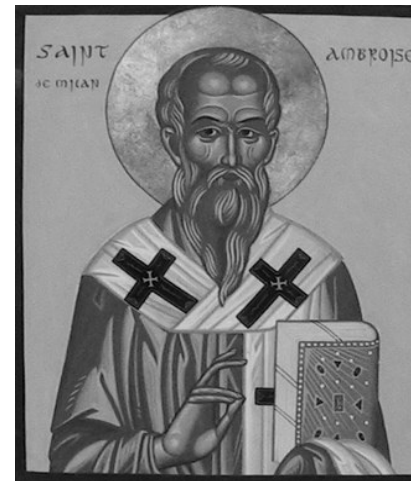
